
ITINERARY

Day 1 (June 16) Arrival in Cottlesville. Introduction of the group and dinner together.

Day 2-6 (June 17-21) Pre-trip orientation and training. Travel to the Exploit Islands and explore maritime, cultural and geological sites. Over the next five days, we'll paddle around the islands, hike, camp, explore uninhabited settlements and talk to locals along the way. You'll enjoy the peace and tranquillity that surrounds this once-booming fishing community while observing the marine wildlife that call this majestic place home.

Day 7 (June 22) Return to Cottlesville. Celebratory dinner and preparation for the journey home the next day.





GENERAL DETAILS AND REQUIREMENTS

Please note details are subject to change.

- **Fundraising Commitment:** In addition to the tuition, we ask that each team member make a minimum donation of \$10,000 toward OBC's Charitable Programs. Team members may also fundraise this amount.
- **Medical Requirements**: This is a physically demanding experience. Participants must complete a medical screening and sign a waiver in advance of the expedition.

Tuition: **\$3,500 CAD**

- Alternative food and beverages throughout the expedition
- · All expenses incurred in the event of early departure or significant delay before, during or after the expedition (evacuation fees, transportation, extra hotel nights, etc.)
